Future Fundraiser Idea: Jessica

- Explored concept of cornhole tournament in lieu of direct sales fundraisers (coupon book sales)
- Exact date, location, fees, details not yet determined.
- Potential for fall fundraiser, to be held at church/school
- Initial concerns about conflicting with athletic association golf outing and SOAR in the fall
- DC West raises \$3500. \$80/team, 30 teams. They use a company that provides the boards which would be paid (\$200) and then possibility of having to provide food/food trucks also needing payment
- Group concerns are the cost being too high (if similar to DC West pricing), not getting enough interest as from the current group of individuals; no one at the meeting is really that interested
- Cost at DC West is perceived to be too high for a pair to participate
- Ideas on incorporating with a Husker game but still lack of interest in this
