

## Home and School Meeting: October 5, 2016

1. **Product Partners:** first turn in was this month. A flier went out in both church bulletins explaining the different fund raising opportunities to help SJS. A new collection bin will be put in both churches for receipts, box tops, fedoras, etc.
  - a. Family Fare is continuing labels for learning
  - b. Idea: post product partner profits in the bulletin to show how much money these can bring in.
  - c. Box tops has an app to scan products and get double points
2. **Directory:** completed & will be sent home soon. 118 people ordered copies this year. SJS printed them, therefore costs were minimal.
3. **School parties:** Get rid of the donuts & opt for a new treat that isn't so messy & costly. Need to be mindful of peanut & gluten free items.
4. **Parent Teacher conferences:** iVolunteer sign up will be ready soon.
5. Dine out for SJS: October has changed from Voodoo Taco (it closed) to Godfathers.
  - a. Ideas for increasing attendance: emphasize it on announcements at the end of the day, bundle it with a special day at school (sprit day, crazy sock day, etc.)
6. **Spirit Store:** Closes on October 12<sup>th</sup>. Each item gives H & S \$1-\$4 profit.
7. **SOAR Table:** H&S is sponsoring a table. A vote was made to determine if H&S would sponsor the whole table or if the attendees sitting at the table would pay for a portion of their ticket. The vote was decided that H&S pay for ½ (\$300) & the 10 people sitting at the table would pay for the other ½ (\$30/person). The money from each person's tickets price will go to gift cards for the Eagles Nest.
8. **Craft Day**-\$417 was made, 30 people in attendance. Spring Date: February 11, 2017 at SEA
9. **Fall Boutique:** 23 vendors signed up, 45 spots are available. Volunteers are needed
10. **Fall Fundraiser:** delivery is October 12<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers are needed.
  - a. New signage for school: \$1000
  - b. 4 new mats for school \$375/mat
